

Technical seminars: HKFRS 15 *Revenue from Contracts with Customers*



HKFRS 15 will be effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018 and will replace the previous revenue standard. The core principle of HKFRS 15 is to recognise revenue to depict the transfer of goods or services to customers in amounts that reflect the consideration to which the company expects to be entitled in exchange for those goods or services. HKFRS 15 will also result in enhanced disclosures about revenue, provide guidance for transactions that were not previously addressed comprehensively and improve guidance for multiple–element arrangements.

This series of seminars is designed to cover the fundamentals and principles of HKFRS 15 and to deal with the practical and complex issues in applying the standard.
