What do the terms Old World wine or New World wine mean? These terms come up often at wine talks but what do they really mean? How to distinguish them? During the January Merry Monday, speaker Mandy Duong will conduct a tasting session comparing different bottles side by side and teaching members how to compare wines produced from these main two categories.

You will sample a hearty red from an organic Australian vineyard made naturally with grapes from up to 80 years old vines, elegant reds from different regions in the right bank of Bordeaux, and a full-bodied South African wine which has been selected to be served in business class on numerous airlines. Mandy will also share her knowledge on wine pairing and tasting techniques.
