The minimum requirement for admission to this course is knowledge of Hong Kong taxation to the level of module D of the Institute's QP (or equivalent). This Course has 6 workshops and 6 tutorials with 33 teaching hours. The medium of instruction is English.

Workshops are held on Saturday afternoons with duration of 3 hours from 2:00pm to 5:00pm.

Tutorials are held on weekday evenings with duration of 2.5 hours from 7:00pm to 9:30pm. Course Fee of this Advanced Hong Kong Tax Course is HK\$15,000, inclusive of a training manual.
