The **Bowling Interest Group (BoIG)** cordially invites you to join Bowling Summer League commencing in May till August 2017. You may form your own team or we will help team you up with other CPA bowlers.

- Dates:** **26 May to 25 August 2017 (all Fridays; 12 sessions)**  
26 May; 2, 9, 16, 23 & 30 June;  
7 & 21 July; 4, 11, 18 & 25 August
- Time:** 8:00 pm – 10:00 pm (starts promptly at 8:00 pm.)
- Venue:** South China Athletic Association Bowling Centre (SCAA)
- Assembly time and place:** **7:30 pm at Section A area of SCAA**
- Fee:**
- **\$1,680** (HKICPA member); **\$1,780** (non-HKICPA member)
  - Fixed fee. No pro rata payment or refund for not being able to participate in all sessions.
  - \$10 for shoes rental (per session).

- Each team will comprise of 3 players, at least two players must be HKICPA members. A team can have a maximum of 3 reserve players: HKICPA members or non-members are both permitted.
  - A total of 12 sessions will be held in the league season. Each player plays 3 games per session, with a handicap in each session.
  - At least half of each team's league games, i.e. 54 out of 108 games (3 games x 3 players x 12 sessions), must be played by HKICPA members.
  - Detailed league rules will be distributed to registered players.  
*(\* To comply with the lane booking requirement, at least one member of each team needs to be a current member of SCAA. If none, one of the teammates has to join SCAA membership at his own cost at HK\$100 for ordinary member.)*

Non-members' applications will only be processed after registration deadline subject to availability. We only consider non-member's enrolment when it is enrolled with a member.
2. The event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number of enrolment is not reached.
3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
