



Technical Update Evening: Application issues of HKFRS 15

The new accounting standard HKFRS 15 *Revenue from Contracts with Customers* is mandatorily effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018. It introduces very significant changes from the old standards in many aspects and contains detailed guidance for recognizing revenue in complex and commonly encountered revenue areas such as multiple element arrangements, construction contracts, warranty and variable consideration.

This seminar will focus on the application issues which will arise upon adoption of HKFRS 15 and how the accounting will be impacted in those situations. The seminar will be delivered at a level which assumes that participants already have a basic understanding of HKFRS 15.
