

# **Snooker League 2017**



To allow CPA snooker players to gain match experience and to promote friendship among members, Snooker Interest Group (SnIG) is organizing a Snooker League (mixed league) to be held in June. Keen snooker players should not miss this opportunity.

### **Rules and Match Format**

#### **Grouping criteria**

The league panel (comprising members of the SnIG Organizing Committee) is tasked with drawing up the match list based on registered players' past performance in practices and tournaments. In the absence of any past records, the players may be invited to participate in a practice to enable the panel to make a proper judgment for grouping purpose.

There will be two divisions and each division has a maximum of 10 players.

Player's achievement in this League will be used as reference for selection of representative team members for future external competitions including the Recreation and Sports Club for HK Professional Bodies Tournament.

#### League format and scoring system

#### Format: Mixed league

#### Scoring system:

#### First Round

- 1. It is a single-round league for each division.
- 2. Each match consists of 1 game with 15 red balls (time limit: 30 mins for each game).
- 3. The scoring system is as follows (per match):

Won 2 marks

Draw 1 mark

Lost 0 mark

- 4. The total number of matches of the league depends on the number of registered players.
- 5. To "qualify" and to be eligible for the final ranking, a player has to complete all of his/her league matches at the end of the match day. However, if a player has suffered from serious injury during the match, he/she will be deemed to lose by 0:2.
- 6. All scheduled matches are subject to weather inclement for re-scheduling.
- 7. The ranking is based on the total marks of each player for each division. The top <u>3</u> players (the "Qualified Players") who gets the highest mark in each division will be qualified to enter into the final round (the "Final Round").
  - (i) If there is a tie, the player who won the relevant matches between the players with equal marks will be ranked at a higher place.
  - (ii) In the event that para 7(i) fails to achieve the desired outcome, the ranking will be determined by the total marks won in all relevant matches.
  - (iii) In the event that para 7(ii) fails to achieve the desired outcome, the ranking will be determined by draw administered by the league panel.

#### **Final Round**

- It is a single-round match.
- 1a. Each match consists of 1 game with 15 red balls (time limit: 30 mins for each game).
- 1b. The scoring system is as follows (per match):

Won 2 marks

Draw 1 mark

Lost 0 mark

- 1c. The player who gets the highest mark in Final Round will be the champion.
  - (i) If there is a tie, the player who won the relevant matches between the players with equal marks will be ranked at a higher place.
  - (ii) In the event that sub-para 1c(i) fails to achieve the desired outcome, the ranking will be determined by the total marks won in all relevant matches.
  - (iii) In the event that sub-para 1c(ii) fails to achieve the desired outcome, the ranking will be determined by draw administered by the league panel.
- 1d. The top four players on the ranking will be the champion, 1st, 2nd and 3rd runner-ups respectively.

### **Rules**

The league adopts the official rules of the games of snooker as issued by the World Professional Billiards & Snooker Association Limited ("WPBSA") where applicable.

SnIG members will be appointed as referee/umpire in the matches on a voluntary basis. Players have the right to raise objection with regards to the decision of the referee/umpire or in the case of foul shot, but they must do so by raising it with league panel on the spot. Upon consultation with the SnIG Co-convenors, their decision shall be final.

The Institute reserves the right to change the format, schedule and rules of the league as and when required without prior notice.
