## **HKICPA** seminar: **IP Protection for Innovation in Financial Sector**

Intellectual property (IP) protects a broad range of rights resulting from various intellectual activities. This seminar provides an overview on how innovation in the financial sector can be protected under PRC and Hong Kong laws. In particular, the speaker will discuss the management of brands and service marks used by financial sector companies.

The seminar will also explore the patent and copyright protection to the business methods and software programmes, and IP-related issues such as the protection of trade secrets, data breach and enforcement options.

After joining this seminar, participants will gain knowledge about:

- Key concepts of IP law and the types of rights
- Scope of IP protection for financial sector companies
- Basic process of brand management
- Basic enforcement options when IP rights are infringed
