Competition Information:

- Events include Men's Singles, Women's Singles, Men's Doubles, and Mixed Doubles
- An event will only proceed if there are at least 4 singles or 4 pairs in the case of doubles
- The maximum number for each event is 32 singles or 12 pairs, subject to change based on the final enrolments
- Each member can join up to 3 events
- The competition will be cancelled if less than 2 events can be held

Match format:

- Contestants will be divided into groups and matches will be conducted in round robin in the preliminary round. Thereafter, the playoffs will be by single knock out. The number of matches varies according to the number of contestants registered.
- Event(s) with less than 6 contestants will be played on single round robin basis.
- There will be 5 games of 11 points in each match; and the contestant who wins 3 games first will win the match.
- The match formats may vary subject to the final number of contestants. Detailed match formats will be announced in due course.
- All matches will be conducted and supervised by professional umpires whose decisions are deemed to be final. No appeal will be entertained.

Awards: Champion and 1st, 2nd and 3rd Runner-up for **each event**

Admission Fee: **\$90** for ONE event; **\$110** for more than one event
