

## Best Corporate Governance Awards series: Awardees share their views and experience on the do's and don'ts of good corporate governance Programme Code: SCPD17101102

Effective risk management and internal control are critical ingredients in the long-term, sustainable success of companies. There are numerous examples of ambitious companies with good prospects, which failed because they ignored, or did not give sufficient attention to, risk management in their strategies and plans, or did not have sound internal control to alert them to impending problems. This is why regulators see these areas as essential in enhancing the transparency of listed companies and strengthening investor protection. In Hong Kong, the requirements in relation to risk management and internal control have continued to be upgraded as recommended best practices in the Corporate Governance Code have progressively become mandatory comply-or-explain provisions. Listed companies are expected to provide investors with more information on their risk management and internal control framework and operation, key risks and how they are managed, and how and when the system is reviewed.

So how do the top performers respond to these changes and continue to raise their corporate governance standard? A good way for companies to strengthen their own governance practices is to learn by example. In this seminar, Ms. Maggie Cheung, the general counsel and company secretary of Hysan Development Company, a regular winner in our Best Corporate Governance Awards, will talk about risk management and internal control from her company's perspective. Institute Council member, Mr. Stephen Law, who has extensive current and previous experience as a private equity investor and as a CFO of BCGA awardees, will join the panel to provide his insights into corporate governance expectations from different perspectives. The panel will be chaired by Mr. Patrick Rozario, chairman of the BCGA Review Panel Committee.
