Capacity: Min. 4 and max. 20

Fee: **RMB\$950/ player**

- Inclusive of land transportation in Mainland, caddie, locker and golf cart on a sharing basis. An additional RMB\$100 for one player using a golf cart.
- Traveling expenses to Huanggang, food costs and other expenses at the golf club will be at players' own account.

Documents required: HKID card and Home Return Permit (回鄉証) / passport with visa to China.

1. Priority for enrollment will first be offered to GIG members and then to non-GIG HKICPA members in the case of over subscription. Non-members' applications will only be processed after registration deadline if the event is not yet full. We only consider non-member's enrollment when it is enrolled with a member.

3. All applicants must sign the attached "declaration" and "assumption of risks and disclaimer of liability" and submit it to the Institute before the activity.
4. The closing date for enrollment is **19 November 2017**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late applications as it sees fit.
