

Technical Update Evening: Transitioning to HKFRS 9

HKFRS 9 *Financial Instruments* will become mandatorily effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018. HKFRS 9 has introduced new requirements regarding the classification and measurement of financial assets and impairment which are significantly different from HKAS 39. In this seminar, we will explain to you the requirements of HKFRS 9 in respect of classification and measurement and impairment with illustrative examples as well as the transitional requirements on these areas.
