Risk Management and Internal Control (SCPD18010801)

Course outline

Effective risk management is considered to be one of the most critical factors for the success of every company. It is imperative that the board and management of companies understand the importance of risk management and develop appropriate internal controls on critical processes, not only to satisfy regulatory requirements (such as the Corporate Governance Code issued by Hong Kong Stock Exchange), but also to survive and thrive especially under today's dynamic and competitive environment. Through establishing a comprehensive system to identify, assess and respond to various types of risks, companies could stay one step ahead of negative events, and turn challenges into opportunities.

In this seminar, the speakers will share their experience in helping companies develop a formal risk management system, as well as the steps in performing risk assessment and developing internal controls. They will also share the trend and best practices of risk management and internal audit.

Extended Enterprise Risk Management (SCPD18032801)

Course outline

With the rapid development of mobile media, digital technology and globalized markets, organizations in all sectors are facing unprecedented changes and competitive threats. As such, the organizations implement increasingly complex business models which rely heavily on third party relationships, such as outsourcing, strategic alliances, joint ventures, licensing/ franchisee agreements or other forms of cooperation to save cost, innovate and enter into new markets. However, companies generally fail to put in the governance structures, systems and controls, as well as effective contracts to manage these "extended enterprise" relationships. The failure may cause the companies to face critical financial, regulatory and reputational risks.

This seminar will discuss about how a company can improve their practices for managing third party risks, the relationships they have with their third parties, and the levels of mutual trust as well as the potential to earn a direct financial benefit and return from performing third party compliance reviews.

Speakers

Mr. Hugh Gozzard, Partner, Deloitte Risk Advisory

Mr. Gozzard is a Partner in Deloitte Hong Kong's Risk Advisory practice. He has 30 years of experience and is responsible for the development and delivery of internal audit, corporate governance, risk management, third party risk management and sustainability services to businesses in Hong Kong, Mainland China and other parts of Asia Pacific. He serves a wide range of organizations including Hong Kong-listed companies, multinationals and Hong Kong public bodies. He has been based in both Deloitte's Hong Kong and Shanghai offices.
