<導師簡介> 鄭凱剛 Caxton Kwong – CK Event and Production 及 C Studio 創辦人、音樂導師、職業結他手、樂隊 Crosstalk 結他手。活躍於香港流行音樂十多年，擅長流行、搖滾和藍調曲風。除負責樂隊創作及擔任樂手演出外，過往更於廣州及香港大會堂，獲邀演出二胡演奏家李軍先生之新二胡唱遊流行夜；另外曾於生力 Wild Day Out Grand Show 演出，同台表演歌手包括黃貫中、恭碩良、蔡健雅、周國賢等。近年更積極參與音樂教育及編曲等工作，當中有伊利沙伯體育館＜樂善好聲演唱會＞無伴奏組合“C Ensemble”四聲部編寫；2016 年為香港會計師公會代表作合唱和音編寫及指導，學生 Jacqueline Hsui 及 Ruth Leung 參加香港專業團體康體會歌唱比賽奪得＜合唱組－季軍＞及＜全場最受觀眾歡迎組別＞獎項。



Advance Class 課程特色:

- 課程當中會以自選歌曲上課，另外亦有一至兩課由老師因應進度不同的學員可應付之能力，指定或由同學互選獨唱或合唱歌曲，擴闊視野作多方面嘗試及針對問題加以改善。
- 完成課程後，可獲邀請於 C Studio 舞台參與演出 Student Mini Concert，享受實際舞台經驗。

<導師簡介> 陳嘉璐 Carol Chan – CK Event and Production 及 C Studio 創辦人、職業歌唱導師、歌手及演唱會和音。踏足香港流行音樂界二十年，擁有豐富大小型演唱會嘉賓及和音經驗，曾帶領多位優秀學生組成和音團隊為演唱會伴唱。亦曾受邀參與演出「謝安琪你們的幸福演唱會」，及為謝安琪『十七度』歌曲 Demo 歌手等等。近年來陳氏專注於培育新一代青年流行歌手包括葉灝基@天堂鳥、女子組合 Bingo、TVB 藝員張雪瑩、陳亭嘉及曾獲得第 33 屆香港電影金像獎最佳新演員提名的余香凝等。最近三年訓練之香港會計師公會代表參加香港專業團體康體會歌唱比賽獲得多個獎項，首先於 2015 年由 Adam Wong 及 Elaine Kwong 奪得＜合唱組－冠軍＞；2016 年學生們更榮獲四個獎項，分別由 Elaine Kwong 奪得＜獨唱組－冠軍＞及＜最佳台風獎＞，Jacqueline Hsui 及 Ruth Leung 奪得＜合唱組－季軍＞，並為香港會計師公會贏得＜我最喜愛演出獎＞獎；2017 年 Natalie Tam 贏得＜獨唱組－亞軍＞，Adam Wong 及 Sandy Ngai 奪得＜合唱組－亞軍＞。

1. Priority of enrolment will be first offered to SglG members and then to non-SglG HKICPA members in the case of over-subscription. Non-members' applications will only be processed after registration deadline, subject to availability. We only consider non-member's enrolment when it is enrolled with a member.
2. The event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number is not reached.
3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
4. The closing date for enrolment is **5 January**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late enrolment as it sees fit.
