About the programme

In line with the plan of the Bridge Interest Group, the training course will focus on the basic technique about bidding, declarer play and the defense. Each will be spent around 2 sessions for the purpose of building up the foundation on what you have learned before together with the experience sharing with the tutor.

Experienced players are encouraged to join this course for the purpose of practicing with their partners to prepare for future tournaments as it is vital to build up a mutual understanding and strategy for the partnership. The training also provides a good opportunity to foster friendship among members and strengthen the team spirit.

The time of the training course will be adequate for the play of 16 boards in a normal team event with opportunity to discuss/account for any particular result during the play with teammates and the tutor. More practice in play, discussion and analysis can reduce your errors in the future. Fewer errors will gradually improve your chance of success and increase your good scores. In addition when you attend in the first session, you know those members who will attend in the later sessions. Therefore you can arrange well in advance with them for one table (rubber) or two tables (team) practice.

If members do not have any knowledge of bridge and wish to enroll in the course, please let us know in advance as we shall try to form a novice group for separate training.

Notes:

1. Priority for enrolment will first be offered to BrIG members and then to non-BrIG HKICPA members in the case of over subscription. Non-members' applications will only be processed after registration deadline if the event is not yet full. We only consider non-member's enrolment when it is enrolled with a member.
2. The event is subject to cancellation should the minimum is not reached.
3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
4. The closing date for enrolment is **15 January 2018**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late applications as it sees fit.
5. Application by fax will ONLY be accepted when payment is made by credit card, Cash is strictly NOT accepted.

7. Unless the activity is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, bad weather or low enrolment, no refund for withdrawal will be entertained after your enrolment has been processed.
8. Bad weather arrangement: The activity will be cancelled if typhoon signal no. 8 or above / Black rainstorm warning is hoisted 2 hours prior to the commencement of the activity. Your enrolment fee will be refunded in full in the event of cancellation due to bad weather, or subject to separate arrangement with the tutor.
