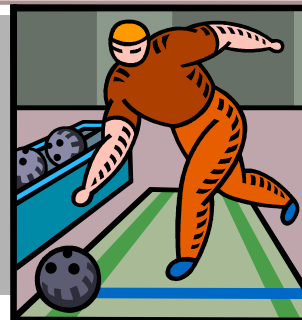




Bowling Training Courses



The **Bowling Interest Group (BolG)** has organized two training courses for members to improve their bowling skill as follows:

Course contents: Basic bowling techniques, skill drills, grip, stance, swing, targeting and all the important mental aspect of the game.

Fixed fee with no pro rata payment or refund for not being able to attend all sessions.

Course Format:

- Two lanes to be shared by participants.

1. Priority for enrolment will first be offered to BoIG members and then to non-BoIG HKICPA members in the case of over subscription. Non-members' applications will only be processed after registration deadline subject to availability. We only consider non-member's enrolment when it is enrolled with a member.
2. The event is subject to cancellation should the number of enrolment is not reached.
3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
4. The closing date for enrolment is **9 February**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late enrolments as it sees fit.
5. Registration by fax will ONLY be processed when payment is made by credit card. Cash is strictly NOT accepted.
6. Successful registrants will receive confirmation by email or by telephone, whereas unsuccessful registrants will receive full refund.

8. Unless the activity is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, low enrolment or bad weather, no refund for withdrawal will be entertained after the enrolment has been processed.
9. Bad weather arrangement: The activity will be cancelled if typhoon signal no. 8 or above / Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted 2 hours prior to the commencement of the activity. In the event of bad weather, a make-up session will be arranged and no refund will be made due to such cancellation.
