1. Priority for enrolment will first be offered to TsIG members and then to non-TsIG HKICPA members in the case of over-subscription. Non-members' applications will only be processed after registration deadline subject to availability. We only consider non-member's enrolment when it is enrolled with a member.
2. The event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number is not reached.
3. Availability of venue will be confirmed by the coach in the preceding week subject to venue availability. The dates shown above are for indicative purpose.
