

BEPS Series: The HKSAR Government's Amendment Bill on New Legislative Measures to Counter BEPS

On 29 December 2017, the HKSAR Government gazetted the Inland Revenue (Amendment) (No. 6) Bill 2017 (the Amendment Bill), covering the following areas:

- Transfer pricing rules and adjustments that can be imposed by the Inland Revenue Department on non-arm's length domestic/ cross border transactions
- Advance Pricing Arrangements
- Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) documentation requirements
- Claims for double taxation relief and consequential obligations
