Field trip details:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Hok Tau Reservoir is located at the Pat Sin Leng Country Park. - It is a typical lowland riverine ecosystem in South China. - The inter-relations among flora and fauna as well as their physical environment help building the complex ecosystem. - This is an area suitable to observe the shifting between diurnal and nocturnal creatures.
