Awards

Awards include Champion, 1st, 2nd and 3rd runner-up of the Premier and Champion Leagues.

Groupings

Based on enrollees' levels and previous match experience, the panel will do their best to group similar level players in each league group to ensure the league will proceed on a fair basis as far as possible.

Generally, anyone who has been HKICPA representative team members or who has competed in advance level at any open tournaments will be grouped under **Level 1 of Premier Group**.

Whereas those who have competed in other lower level at any external competitions with official results will be grouped under **Level 2 of Premier Group** and the rest will be grouped under **Level 1 or 2 of Champion Group** according to their past performance.

Table Tennis Leagues – Rules and Information

Handicaps

- ♦ They are mixed leagues. Handicap is assigned based on the player's past performance in practice/tournaments as assessed and confirmed by the league panel, which comprises the TTIG convenor and two members appointed by him. For newly joined TTIG members and those with no past performance record, they will be invited to participate in a general practice for the purpose of confirming their league groups they have enrolled for or the level to which they belong.
- ♦ There are 2 levels in each league group. A level-2 player will get 1 handicap point for each game when playing against a level-1 player. A level-2 female player will get 2 handicap points when playing against a male player of the same level and 3 handicap-points against a level-1 male player in the same group.
- ♦ The league panel can change the league group for which players have enrolled or determine their level according to their past performance or after their assessment and no appeal to grouping will be entertained.

League format and scoring system

1. It will be a single-round league.
2. Each match consists of 2 games of 11 game points. The winner in any game is the player who first scores 11 points. In the event of deuce, a game will be won by the first player who gains a two-point lead.



3. The scoring system is as follows (per match):

Won	2 marks
Draw	1 mark
Lost	0 mark

4. The total number of matches of the league depends on the number of registered players.
5. To qualify and be eligible for the final ranking, a player has to complete all the matches at the end of the league. The Institute, however, has the right to exercise its discretion in exceptional cases e.g. when the player has suffered from serious injury (in which case he/she will be deemed to lose by 0:2) .
6. The league will come to an end after completion of all the matches as scheduled. Except in the event of weather inclement on match-day, in which case the remaining matches will be re-scheduled.
7. Overall ranking is based on the total marks scored by each player. The player with the highest points in the relevant league group will be the champion.
 - (i) If there is a tie, the player who won the relevant matches between the two players will be ranked at a higher place.
 - (ii) In the event that para. 7(i) fails to achieve the desired outcome, the ranking will be determined by the total number of matches won.
 - (iii) In the event that para. 7(ii) fails to achieve the desired outcome, the ranking will be determined by the total number of games won and then the number of individual scores made.
 - (iv) In the event that para. 7(iii) fails to achieve the desired outcome, the ranking will be determined by draw administered by the Institute or its delegate.
8. The top four players on the ranking in each group will be the champion, 1st, 2nd and 3rd runner up respectively.

Example:

*Below is an illustration of the league rules based on a **total of 15 league players:***

- (a) Each player has to play a total of 14 matches under the single-round league format.*
- (b) By the end of the league period, a player has to complete all the 14 matches in order to be eligible for the final ranking.*

Table tennis rules

In principle, all match rules will be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF). However, players should understand the practical difficulty in enforcing these rules as the league is not intended to be a professional tournament and the main objective of the league is to promote fellowship among TTIG members.

TTIG members will be appointed as umpires to the matches. Players have the right to raise objection with regard to the decision of the umpire or in the case of suspected foul play but they must do so by raising it with the TTIG convenor/deputy convenor on the spot. Upon consultation with his panel members, his decision shall be final.

The Institute reserves the right to change the format, schedule and rules of the league as and when required without prior notice.
