Notes on enrolment:

1. Priority for enrolment will first be offered to DIG members and then to non-DIG HKICPA members in the case of over-subscription. Non-members' applications will only be processed after registration deadline subject to availability. We only consider non-member's enrolment when it is enrolled with a member.
2. The event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number is not reached.
3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
4. The closing date for enrolment is **12 April 2018**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late applications as it sees fit.
