

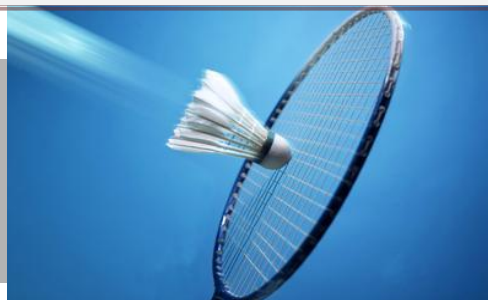

Non-members' applications will only be processed after registration deadline, subject to availability. We only consider non-member's enrolment when it is enrolled with a member.
2. The event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number is not reached.
3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
4. The closing date for enrolment is **26 April**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late enrolment as it sees fit.
