HKFRS 9 Financial Instruments

HKFRS 9 *Financial Instruments* became effective on 1 January 2018 and replaced HKAS 39 *Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement.* The standard introduces a new approach to classification and measurement of financial assets based on the entity's business model and an instrument's cash flow characteristics. It also introduces a new forward-looking impairment model which requires earlier recognition, and ongoing assessment of credit losses. The hedge accounting requirements under HKFRS 9 are more principles based and more closely aligned with the entity's risk management practices.

These workshops cover the new concepts and the practical issues and business impact that companies should consider.
