

Swimming Classes



We are pleased to offer the following structured swimming classes in response to members' demand:

Beginner

- For members who are non-swimmers or have very rudimentary swimming skills
- Covers pool safety, basics of floating, movement and control in the water

Intermediate

- For members who are able to swim at least one stroke freestyle or breaststroke
- Covers improving all around swimming technique and backstroke

Advanced

- For members who are well rounded in at least three competitive strokes
- Covers swimming technique improvement for all four strokes

Two 25m lanes will be used exclusively for the training. Experienced swimmers (intermediate and advanced levels) and novice players (beginner level) will be trained separately in different lanes by different coach. Trainers will teach based on individuals' level and capability. Swimmers are encouraged to learn a new swimming style one after the other.

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Dates: Class A: Every Tuesday - Any 10 sessions between 7 August and 30 October 2018

(except 25 September - public holiday)

Class B: Every Thursday - Any 10 sessions between 2 August and 25 October 2018
