

Business Valuation for IPO and Corporate Transaction Circular

Business valuation has become an integral part of financial reporting and regulatory reporting. This seminar will identify items which commonly require valuation in an IPO. For companies that are already listed on the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong, they are subject to Listing Rule disclosure requirements when undertaking merger & acquisition or disposal of assets activities. In many cases, valuations of the underlying assets of these transactions are required and valuation reports have to be disclosed in circulars to shareholders.

This seminar will cover the regulatory issues in corporate transactions, with focus on related valuations.

- Common valuation items in an IPO
- Notifiable transactions and relevant disclosure requirements
- Merits of market approach vs income approach
- Handling of enquiries from regulators on valuations
