Note: Registration is on a first-come first-served basis.

Rules and Match Format

- 1. Teams of males and females players, or mixed team of male and female players are allowed.
- 2. Each team should comprise of 3 players. One additional player as reserve is optional.
- 3. Teams will be divided into groups. Single round robin system will be adopted in the preliminary round, while single knock-out in the playoff round.
- 4. Each game consists of 10 minutes each, and each team allows one 1-minute (stopped clock) timeout during a game.
- 5. The game is played on a half court with one basketball.
- 6. A coin toss shall determine which team gets the first possession.
- 7. Every shot made from inside the arc will be awarded 1 point. Every shot made from outside of the arc will be awarded 2 points.
- 8. The first team to score 21 points or more wins the game if it happens within the 10-minute regular playing time.
- 9. If the score is tied, an extra period of 5 minutes will be played. There will be an interval of 1 minute before the overtime starts. The first team to score 2 points in the overtime wins the game.
- Format and number of matches are subject to the number of registered teams.
- 11. Detailed information of the competition rules and format will be circulated to successful registrants.
- 12. Medals will be awarded to each player of the champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up team. Prize presentation will be held immediately after the competition.

Notes:

- 1. This event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number is not reached.
- Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
- 3. The closing date for enrolment is <u>11 February 2019</u>. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late enrolments after the closing deadline as it sees fit.
- 4. Registration by fax will ONLY be processed when payment is made by credit card. Cash is strictly NOT accepted.
- 5. Successful registrants will receive confirmation by email or by telephone, whereas unsuccessful registrants will receive full refund.
- 6. If you do not hear from us by <u>15 February 2019</u>, please contact Miss Sharon Ngai at 2287 7067 / Miss Denise Kwok at 2287 7253.
- 7. Unless the activity is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances or bad weather, no refund for withdrawal will be entertained after the enrolment has been processed.
- 8. Bad weather arrangement: The activity will be cancelled if typhoon signal no. 8 or above / Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted 2 hours prior to the commencement of the matches. The match will be re-scheduled.
- The Institute has the final decisions to increase the max, teams in case of over-enrolment.
- 10. The Institute reserves the rights to revise or amend the rules of the competition without prior notice and its interpretation is deemed to be final.
- 11. The Institute reserves the right to change the venue and date of the event due to unforeseen circumstances.
