# Challenges on Resumption of Listing

# **About the topic**

The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong released consultation conclusions in July 2019 to tighten the rules on backdoor listings (i.e. reverse takeover (RTO)). Since the change in the rules, the view is that insolvency practitioners find resumptions through an RTO much more difficult, or even impossible to achieve. Is this myth or truth? How does an RTO compare with an initial public offering (IPO)?

Mr. Warren Lee is a founder and the managing director of Yu Ming and the Chairman of SHK Hong Kong Industries Limited (SHK Industries) (Stock code: 666). He has been a director of Yu Ming since August 1996, and worked for Sun Hung Kai International Limited between 1992 and 1997, and ABN Amro Bank N.V. between 1988 and 1992. He joined SHK Industries as a manager in July 1992 and became its Chairman in March 2009.

Mr. Lee is licensed to carry out type 1, 4, 6 and 9 regulated activities under the Securities and Futures Ordinance, and is active in advising corporate finance transactions involving Hong Kong listed companies. He has advised well over 430 corporate finance transactions since 1992, some of which complex and difficult, and some even controversial, with a few leading to the change of the Takeovers Code.
