Live webinar: HKFRS 3 Business Combinations

COURSE HIGHLIGHTS:

The amendments to HKFRS 3 *Business Combinations* was effective on 1 January 2020, which revise the definition of a business and introduce the optional concentration test. This webinar will go through the amendments and the differences in accounting for business combinations and asset acquisitions.

In addition, the webinar will share with participants some common application issues in applying HKFRS 3, including:

- Identifying the acquirer
- Determining the acquisition date
- Recognising and measuring consideration transferred
- Recognising and measuring assets acquired and liabilities assumed
- Measurement period
- Disclosures
- Interaction of HKFRS 3 with other standards, including HKFRS 10 Consolidated Financial Statements, HKAS 7 Statement of Cash Flows, HKAS 12 Income Taxes, and HKAS 36 Impairment of Assets.

This webinar will also provide an update of the development of IASB's projects relating to business combinations, namely the projects on business combinations under common control and goodwill and impairment.
