Foreign financial assets reporting and compliance procedures for U.S. persons (including Green Card holders)

About the topic

About the event

In the era of the Foreign Account Tax Compliance Act (FATCA), ownership of foreign financial assets presents unique compliance challenges for U.S. persons, including Green Card holders, residing in Hong Kong. The annual reporting requirements of Report of Foreign Bank and Financial Accounts (FBAR) as well as Form 8938 - Statement of Specified Foreign Financial Assets (SFFAs) are complex and each regime has separate rules and filing requirements. For example, if you or your clients are a US person holding Hong Kong financial assets such as insurance, pensions, securities accounts, or have a financial interest in Hong Kong companies or partnerships, there are specific information return filing requirements. Failure to comply with these reporting requirements may result in severe penalties. US persons and their advisers should appraise themselves with the requirements and common pitfalls for FATCA reporting, and understand the compliance procedures available to rectify for failure to report.

In this live webinar, the speakers will:

- Discuss how living in Hong Kong impacts the complex nature of various foreign assets filing requirements (including FBAR, Form 8938, foreign gift reporting).
- Provide insights and explore the eligibility criteria on the compliance procedures.
