E-learning: Interaction between Risk-Based Capital and HKFRS 17 *Insurance Contracts*

COURSE HIGHLIGHTS:

The Hong Kong Insurance Authority is developing a new Hong Kong Risk-based Capital (HKRBC) regime for the insurance industry in Hong Kong. The HKRBC is expected to be effective in 2024. On the other hand, a new insurance financial reporting standard issued by the HKICPA, HKFRS 17 *Insurance Contracts*, will be effective from 1 January 2023. The speakers of this live webinar will explain to you the key elements of the HKRBC including the key assumptions and methodology for the HKRBC, and how the HKRBC would interact with HKFRS 17 and the related impact on the Hong Kong insurers.
