# Proposed company re-domiciliation regime in Hong Kong

## About the topic

In the 2023/24 Budget, the Financial Secretary announced a proposal to introduce a general company redomiciliation regime to facilitate non-Hong Kong companies to re-domicile to Hong Kong, following on from the introduction of more specific re-domiciliation mechanisms for open-ended fund companies and limited partnership funds, in 2021. A public consultation was conducted during March to May 2023 to collect stakeholders' comments on the key features of the proposed regime, and the submission made by the Institute can be found <a href="here">here</a>. Under the proposed regime, a re-domiciled company would have the same rights and obligations as any Hong Kong-incorporated company.
