

# HKICPA Webinar Series: Towards an Effective and Efficient Audit

## COURSE HIGHLIGHTS:

**Audit sampling, journal entry testing**, the use of **external confirmations** and **audit documentation** have consistently been the areas of focus of audit quality reviewers and regulators. This is largely due to the repeated deficiencies identified in these areas. To enhance audit quality, auditors must thoroughly understand the relevant requirements to design and perform appropriate audit procedures, thereby ensuring an effective and efficient audit.

In this training series, speakers will highlight and elaborate on relevant requirements with illustrative examples. They will also discuss some of the pitfalls identified through the recent Accounting and Financial Reporting Council inspections.

These webinars encourage interactive learning. A Q&A session will be included that allows participants to ask questions and explore the topics in more detail.
