ABOUT THE SEMINAR

In July 2024, the Institute issued *Revisions to the Code Addressing Tax Planning and Related Services* as a result of the IESBA's final pronouncement, setting an ethical framework to guide professional accountants when providing tax planning and related services. This principles-based framework stipulates the expected mindset and behaviors of professional accountants when they recommend or advise on tax planning arrangements to employing organizations or clients. The revisions will be effective from 1 July 2025 with early adoption encouraged.

In this webinar, speakers will cover:

- Key changes to the *Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants*; and
- Implications of the revisions in tax practice.

A Q&A session will also be included which provides opportunities for participants to explore the subject in more detail and ask questions.
