## ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Practising members are sometimes engaged to issue an Accountant's Report on a firm of solicitors, who are required to deliver an Accountant's Report to the Council of The Law Society of Hong Kong (Law Society) once in each practice year. The report is prepared with regard to the requirements of the Solicitors' Accounts Rules and Accountant's Report Rules made under the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Cap. 159).

In the first session of the e-learning, Mr. Nasir, a solicitor, will explain the Solicitors' Accounts Rules through the Nasirs® Hour-Glass Matrix<sup>SM</sup> and highlight the common breaches of such obligations.

During the second session, Mr. Chow, a professional accountant, will provide an explanation of the recommended work procedures outlined in PN 840. Additionally, he will share prevalent challenges and breaches commonly encountered while undertaking engagements to issue an Accountant's Report.
