Participants must complete each session and pass its quizzes (with a minimum score of 80% to pass and unlimited attempts) before progressing to the next topic.</i> 3. <i>The final assessment is mandatory, requiring a minimum score of 70% to pass. It consists of a 90-minute online test featuring 60 multiple-choice questions. Participants are allowed up to 3 attempts to achieve a passing score.</i> 4. <i>Participants who have successfully completed each module and its associated quizzes will receive digital badges for the respective modules. Upon passing the final assessment, a full completion e-Certificate and the designated badge will be awarded, recognizing your overall achievement in the programme.</i>
