These standards provide a consistent, scalable approach to help entities meet global expectations and strengthen Hong Kong’s position as a leading green finance hub.

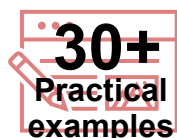

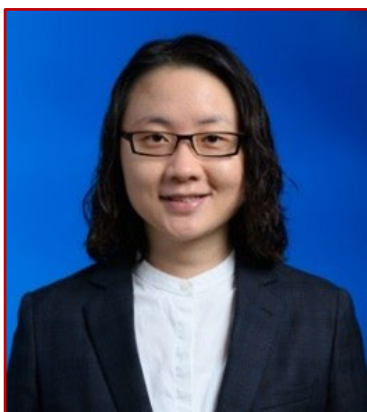
