

Any enrolment in the activity is based on the participant's assessment that he or she is fit to participate and the assumption of all the risks and hazards inherent in the said activity. The participant agrees not to hold HKICPA or the convenor of the interest group liable for any loss or damage that the participant may suffer as a result of the participation. Where an external third party has been engaged to arrange the activity, the participant further agrees that the third party is solely responsible for any liability which may result from the activity.

Any failure to follow such instructions will result in the participant's exclusion from the activity. The convenor of the interest group or trainer (if any) may determine, in the interests of safety or other considerations, whether an activity shall continue or whether a particular participant is allowed to continue to participate.

1. Registration is on a first-come first-served basis.
2. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
3. The closing date for enrolment is **15 March**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late enrolments as it sees fit.
4. Successful registrants will receive confirmation by email or by telephone, whereas unsuccessful registrants will receive full refund.

6. Unless the activity is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances or bad weather, no refund for withdrawal will be entertained after the enrollment has been processed.
7. Bad weather arrangement: The activity will be cancelled if typhoon signal no. 8 or above / Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted 2 hours prior to the commencement of the course.
8. The event organizer reserves the right to change the venue and date of the course due to unforeseen circumstances.

Personal Data:
