## Golf Day at Kau Sai Chau (East/South Course) in March 2026

The **Golf Interest Group (GIG)** has organized a golf day in March at Kau Sai Chau for different levels of players. The South Course is more player-friendly for beginners or high-handicappers, while the East Course is more challenging and suitable for experienced players.

### Details

Date: **28 March 2026 (Saturday)**

Time: **East Course - Tee off time at 12:00, 12:09**  
**South Course - Tee off time at 12:02, 12:10**

Venue: **Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course (KSC), Sai Kung**

Handicap requirement: **South Course - Men / Ladies at 54 or below**  
**East Course - Men / Ladies at 30 or below**  
• Participants are required to indicate whether they have the KSC Golf Pass, or latest official handicap index (issued by HK Golf Association or other recognized golf associations / clubs).

Capacity: 2 flights for East Course and 2 flights for South Course

Lunch: Lunch will be at players' own expenses

Remarks:

- KSC provides complimentary use of electric golf cart on a sharing basis (not allowed on fairways or areas with turf). Golfers under 18 years of age are not permitted to drive electric golf cart.
- In accordance with Road Traffic (Village Vehicle) Regulations, all golf cart drivers must hold a valid driving license.
- No caddy service is provided.
- Ferry service departing from Sai Kung at 20-minute interval, on the clock, 20-min and 40-min past.
- There will be no group assembly and players please register individually at the Course Reception Counter on G/F, Administration Building.
- Players are required to bring their own golf gear and wear proper golf attire and shoes.
- Locker / changing room facilities are provided by KSC on a complimentary basis.
- The course will be closed when typhoon signal no.3 is hoisted or under black rainstorm / lightning / or any unforeseeable dangers. Under these circumstances, the golf day will be cancelled.
- **KSC policy does NOT offer refund for late cancellation and/or no-show after confirmation.**

1. Priority for enrollment will first be offered to GIG members and then to non-GIG HKICPA members in the case of over subscription.
2. This event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number is not reached.
3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
4. The convenors have the discretion to accept late enrolments after the closing deadline as they see fit.
5. Unless the activity is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, low enrollment or bad weather, no refund for withdrawal will be entertained after the enrollment has been processed.
6. Bad weather arrangement: The activity will be cancelled if typhoon signal no. 3 or above is hoisted, or black rainstorm warning is hoisted 2 hours prior to assembly time.
7. The convenors reserve the right to change the venue and date of the course/event due to unforeseen circumstances.
