- Venue: South China Athletic Association Bowling Centre (SCAA)
- Assembly time and place: **10:10 am at the registration counter in Section A area**
- Fee: **\$260 (inclusive of 4 games)**
- Eligible player: **HKICPA members, QP students/ graduates & IA (Primarily for HKICPA members)**
- Capacity: Min 16 (max 20)
- Format:
- Four games for each contestant.
 - No handicap will be considered in scoring.
 - There will be 3 grades, namely A, B and C. The average score of the 4 games played will determine which "grade" a contestant will be competing in. The highest scorer of each grade will be the champion.

 - Contestant can bring their own bowling equipment if they wish.
- Prizes:
- Champion, 1st Runner-Up and 2nd Runner-Up for **each grade**.

(Prize presentation will be held immediately after the competition.)
- Remarks: Contestant's results will be used as reference for the selection of representative team members for future external competitions including the Recreation and Sports Club for HK Professional Bodies Tournament.
