1. Registration is on a first-come first-served basis. Priority for enrolment will first be offered to BmlG members and then to non-BmlG HKICPA members in the case of over subscription.
2. This event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number is not reached.
3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
4. The closing date for enrolment is **27 April 2026**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late enrolments after the closing deadline as it sees fit.
5. Successful registrants will receive confirmation by email or by telephone, whereas unsuccessful registrants will receive full refund.

7. Unless the activity is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, low enrolment or bad weather, no refund for withdrawal will be entertained after the enrolment has been processed.
