As organizations respond to climate-related risks and opportunities, transition planning is becoming increasingly important in supporting long-term business resilience, competitiveness and sustainable growth. A credible climate transition plan can help translate climate ambitions and targets into practical actions, while explaining how an organization intends to navigate the transformation towards a low-carbon economy and respond to a changing climate.

This webinar will provide a practical introduction to climate transition planning - from understanding what a transition plan is, to developing its key components and communicating the plan through sustainability disclosures. It will also explain how transition planning connects with relevant HKFRS S1 and HKFRS S2 requirements.

- Walk through practical steps involved in developing a transition plan that translates strategic ambitions into clear actions and implementation.
- Discuss how transition plan information can be translated into decision-useful disclosures, with reference to relevant HKFRS S1 and HKFRS S2 requirements.
