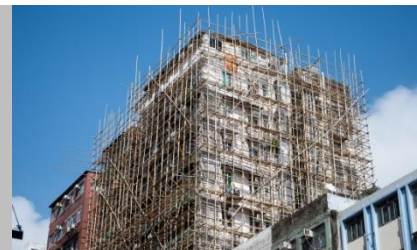

HKICPA PICIG x HKBAA seminar:

Building management and renovation oversight

(Programme Code: SCPD26092801)



In light of the widespread public concern arising from fire outbreaks and alleged bid riggings related to building management and maintenance works, significant public and regulatory attention has been drawn to the critical vulnerabilities within corporate tendering, procurement, and vendor oversight systems. For professional accountants working in the property, infrastructure and construction sectors, managing property assets and large-scale renovation projects goes beyond simple cost control. It also demands rigorous risk management, compliance monitoring, and robust internal controls.

Co-organized by the Institute's Property, Infrastructure and Construction Interest Group and the Hong Kong Business Accountants Association, this seminar will feature distinguished speakers from the surveying profession, the Legislative Council, and the Independent Commission Against Corruption. The speakers will share insights from real-world cases and lessons learned, exploring both limitations and opportunities for improvements in law and practice. Members will gain a comprehensive understanding of the technical standards, legislative developments, anticorruption controls, and financial governance needed to safeguard corporate oversight in major building works.

Since 2025, Ms Poon has been cross-posted to the Corruption Prevention Department responsible for formulating corruption prevention advice for government and public bodies.

Hon Tang Ka-piu, Bill, is currently the Deputy Chairman of the Hong Kong Federation of Trade Unions and a Member of the Council of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). Graduated from CUHK, Bill previously served as an Islands District Councillor. He first entered the Legislative Council in 2012 representing the Labour Functional Constituency, was later elected to represent the Kowloon East Geographical Constituency in 2021, and successfully secured his re-election in 2025.

As the Chairman of the Panel on Home Affairs, Culture and Sports at the Legislative Council, he placed a strong emphasis on policy reforms surrounding building renovation and estate management. He strived to eradicate bid-rigging practices, safeguard owners' rights, and streamline the governance of property owners' corporations and driving amendments to the Building Management Ordinance. Simultaneously, he actively organizes consultative meetings and discussion forums with key stakeholders, including property owners' corporations, building management professionals, and residents, to gather feedbacks and channel community insights into the legislative process for building renovation policy changes.

Sr Vincent Ho is a qualified Professional Building Surveyor since 1991 and has over 30 years of relevant experience.
