

## E-learnings: **HKFRS 17 *Insurance Contracts* – Audit and Financial Reporting Issues (Part 1 and Part 2)**

Since its effective date of 1 January 2023, the new comprehensive insurance accounting standard, HKFRS 17 *Insurance Contracts*, has been in effect for over a year. However, its tangible visibility in every market has only become evident with the publication of the first set of audited annual financial statements compliant with HKFRS 17. HKFRS 17 has brought significant changes in the recognition, measurement as well as presentation and disclosures of insurance contracts as compared to the superseded HKFRS 4 *Insurance Contracts*.

We are launching two e-learnings to share with participants the significant and challenging issues relating to transitioning and implementing the requirements of HKFRS 17. These e-learning will provide insights from both accounting and auditing perspectives, based on the experiences gained during the first complete reporting cycle under the new standard. Our speakers, who are deep experts in HKFRS 17 implementation and its audit, will share their experience and observations.

The first session, scheduled in March 2024, will focus on the salient financial reporting features that have emerged from the first set of financial statements prepared under HKFRS 17. The second session, taking place in May 2024, will discuss how the audit profession approached the first full audit of HKFRS 17 financial statements and what lies ahead for Hong Kong insurers beyond this important milestone. We believe that the e-learnings will provide participants with valuable knowledge and enhance their professional effectiveness as professional accountants and/or auditors.
