Notes to participants:

- All participants must agree with the "Declaration, Assumption of Risks and Disclaimer of Liability" when they enrol. For guests under the age of 18, the "Declaration, Assumption of Risks and Disclaimer of Liability" must be explained to them and signed by their parents/guardians.
- Guests under the age of 18 must be accompanied by their parents/ guardians at all-time during the activity who shall be personally responsible for the safety, wellbeing and behavior of such guests.
- The fee includes a light dinner. Participants can bring their own food and drinks.
- Participants are required to comply with the safety guidelines as set out by the boat rental company and boat owner.
- Participants are required to take care of their own personal belongings and possessions. In the event of any loss or damage occurring on board the boat, the Institute, the boat rental company and boat owner will not be held responsible.
- In the event of adverse weather conditions, the boat owner has the discretion to determine whether to embark on the journey or adjust the day's route itinerary, always prioritizing safety.
- Typically, the boat trip will continue as scheduled if Typhoon Signal No. 1 or an Amber/Red Rainstorm Warning is in effect. If Typhoon Signal No. 3 or higher, or a Black Rainstorm Warning, remains hoisted two hours prior to the boarding time, the event will be rescheduled.
- More information related to the activity such as assembly details, adverse weather arrangements, etc. will be provided to the successful registrants later. The mobile contact of participants will be provided to the event convenor and helpers for creating a WhatsApp group to facilitate communication.
