How forensic accountants assist in matrimonial cases

About the topic

Divorce is one of the most painful experiences. Worse still, the underlying processes like getting hold of alimony payments, and division of assets could become very contentious. In order to settle the disputes among the concerned parties as soon as possible, family lawyers would need assistances such as appointing a forensic accountant to, for example, search for hidden assets/ income, calculate the cash flow for maintenance payments, perform a business valuation.

In this seminar, an experienced legal practitioner will talk about the attributes a family lawyer looks for in appointing forensic accountants and her working experience with forensic accountants.
