#### **ABOUT THE SEMINAR**

In recent years, more and more countries including Singapore and the UK have mandated the use of Building Information Modelling ("BIM") for their public sector projects. In the 2017 Policy Address by the Chief Executive, it is noted that the HKSAR Government would also require consultants and contractors to use BIM technology when undertaking design of major government capital works projects from 2018 onwards.

BIM is an innovative technology for bridging communications between the architecture, engineering and construction industries. It is an automated process of generating three-dimensional, digital representation of building data throughout its life cycle. Apart from three dimensional images, BIM can potentially provide more speedy and effective analysis in respect of time and cost impacts of the design and the changes thereto, resulting in better cost control and estimation of the project, which is of high value to accountants working in the construction and property sectors.

At the seminar, the speakers will address:

- · What is BIM?
- Why we need BIM?
- The cost and benefit of using BIM technology to the corporate users
- Latest development in the use of BIM technology by the HKSAR Government : from vertical to horizontal applications.
