ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Data centres are an essential and integral aspect of the infrastructure for a knowledge-based digital economy, which sustain continuous economic development and entrench Hong Kong's position as a trading and financial center. As businesses today are becoming more and more data-driven, it has been forecasted that global data traffic will increase at a compound annual growth rate of 25% from 2014 to 2019. In order to advance their digital agendas, enterprises across almost all industries would either have to build their own data centres, or lease such facilities for their business operations. As such, it is imperative that businesses equip themselves with a better understanding of cyber risks, regulatory and security issues related to data centre operation and leasing.

At the seminar, the speaker will highlight the key considerations when selecting a data centre that conforms to regulatory standards in areas such as risk management, data security and leasing practices.
