



## Best Corporate Governance Awards series: Awardees share their views and experience on the do's and don'ts of good corporate governance

Regulators are continually updating corporate governance rules and regulations to enhance the transparency of listed companies and strengthen investor protection. Recent changes in Hong Kong include upgrading the Environmental, Social and Governance Reporting Guide under the listing rules, requiring listed companies to disclose more information about their environmental and sustainability policies and practices. Best practices in risk management and internal control under the Corporate Governance Code have progressively become mandatory comply-or-explain provisions.

How do the top performers respond to such changes and raise their governance standard beyond basic compliance? Perhaps the best way for companies to take their corporate governance practices to the next level is to learn by example.
