This module from the Financial Controllership Programme (FCP) will highlight the important role of the financial controller in setting the culture and code of ethics in a business. Participants will be able to learn about the fundamental concepts and requirements in Hong Kong, mainland China and other major jurisdictions. They will be equipped with practical strategies to eliminate or at least to reduce the business integrity risks that may surface within their business organizations. They will also be empowered with the necessary skills to instill ethical values and practices in their finance team and where possible in the whole organization.
