He was Chief Technology Officer when he left Cyberport in February 2016.

Dr. Chung has been active in performing public service to serve for different associations, NGOs and universities.

Dr. Chung holds a Bachelor of Science (Engineering) degree in Computer Science from Imperial College London, a Postgraduate Diploma in Business Management from the Chinese University of Hong Kong, a MBA from the Open University of Hong Kong and a Doctorate in Engineering Management from the City University of Hong Kong.
