## ABOUT THE SEMINAR

On 22 September 2017, the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited published consultation papers on (1) <u>Capital Raisings by Listed Issuers</u>; and (2) <u>Delisting and Other Rule Amendments</u>.

These papers include proposed changes to the Exchange's Listing Rules to (a) introduce targeted measures to address potential abuses related to large scale deeply discounted capital raising activities and address specific issues concerning other capital raising and share issuance; and (b) improve the effectiveness of the delisting framework and address the issue of prolonged suspension of trading in issuers' listed securities, respectively.

At this seminar, Messrs. Max Cheng and Joseph Choi will explain the HKEX proposals relating to capital raisings by listed issuers and its delisting framework. They will also answer questions raised by the participants.
